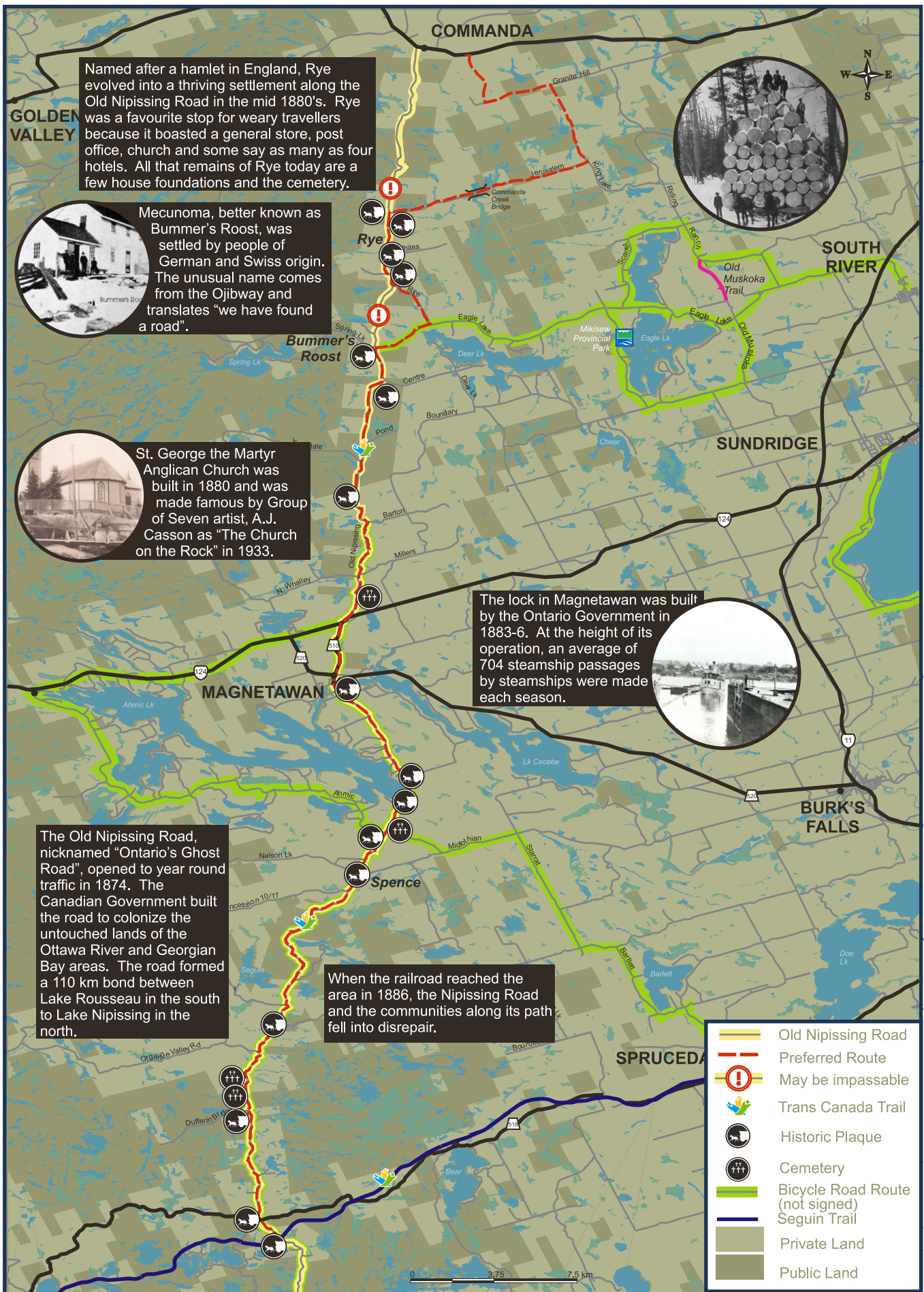


OLD NIPISSING ROAD



USE AT YOUR OWN RISK AND RESPECT OTHER USERS

Once a colonization road to early settlers and now part of The Great Trail aka Trans Canada Trail, the **Old Nipissing Road** tells tales of hope, hardship and perseverance. Modern day explorers will experience conditions similar to those of our ancestors as they travel along the historic route. While the south end and mid-sections around the community of Magnetawan continue to be used and maintained as a travelled road, the north end of the road is slowly being reclaimed by nature. This once thriving road has many sections that have become impassable to all types of trail users. Trail maintenance along the upper reaches is at the hands of local volunteers and does not occur on a regular basis. Directional signage was installed in 2015.

Caution is advised along the entire length of this historic route.
